Here at 110 Rochester Row, we're committed to being as sustainable and green as possible so we've signed up to the Green Tourism initiative.

We'd like you to be part of this too so here are 7 things you can do when you're visiting the venue to help us and the environment.

- Leave the car behind – If only for a day, walk, cycle, or use public transports.
- Use water wisely – Remember to take advantage of our dual flush toilet system.
- Avoid food waste – We want you to enjoy our catering but please be mindful with your food and drinks; remember you can always return to the buffet for a top-up.
- Reduce plastic waste – We supply freshly filtered chilled water which is bottled on site. If you bring your own reusable water bottle, we'll happily refill it for you before you leave using our water filter system.
- Avoid general waste – You are welcome to take home your paper pad and pencil, but give it a think before you do; if these will just end up in the bin you might as well leave it with us to be reused.
- Conserve energy – Our meeting rooms are all set to the most ideal temperature for working however if you choose to regulate the temperature of your room, choose a mild temperature instead of switching from too cool to too hot multiple times.
